Harrison according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, "An Act making further provision for the sale of the public lands" for the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section five, in Township twenty four of range thirteen east, in the particle of lands subject to sale at Tuskaloosa Alabama, containing thirty nine acres, and ninety five and a quarter hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the GeneralLand Office bythe Surveyor General which said tracts has sbeen purchased by the said James J. Harrison.

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity withthe several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents dogive and grant unto the said James J. Harrison and to his heirs, the said tract above described; To have and to hold the same together with allthe rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of what soever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said James J. Harrison and to his heirs and assigns forever.
