Personally appeared before me the undersigned authority in and for said County and said State M. M. Moreland, who being by me duly sworn says as follows:

I am well acquainted with that certain tract of land in Shelby County, Alabama, which from the abstract is described to me as the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Sec. 7, Town, 24, Range 12 east in Shelby County, Alabama. This quarter section is known to me as part of the Huckabee land. I came to Alabama sixty years ago from South Carolina and I have lived within two or three miles of the Huckabee land about sixty years. When I was a boy I remember the land being in the possession of Edward M. Charleton. He was living on the land at that time and continued to live there until he sold the land to C. C. Huckabee. Huckabee lived there on the land for several years and moved away. Huckabee has been dead for more than twenty years. He had some grandchildren surviving him. I do not know where they are at this time.

During the time that Charleton had possession of the land his possession was actual, open, exclusive, hostile, visible, notorious and continuous from the time I first knew the land about sixty years ago until he sold the land to Huckabee.
