WHEREAS, David Fulton of Shelby County, Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuskaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made bythe said David Fulton according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the public lands" for the east half of the southwest quarter of Section twelve, the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section eleven, the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section fourteen, and the southwest quarter of Section thirteen, in Township twenty one of Range three west, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuskaloosa Alabama, containing three hundred and twenty acres, and ninety two and a half hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office bythe Surveyor General which said tracts have been purchased by the said David Fulton.

NOW MOW YE, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, and in conformity withthe several Acts of Congress insuchasse made and provided, HAVE GIVENANDGR ANTED and by these presents dogive and grant, unto the said David Fulton and to his heirs, the said tracts above described; To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges, immunities and appurtenances of what soever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said David Fulton and to his heirs and assigns forever.

Intestimony whereof I, James Buchanan President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office tobe hereuntoaffixed.
