Begin at the southwest corner of northeast quarter of southwest quarter (NE of SWE) Section twenty three (23), Township twenty (20), hange three (3) west; thence north and parallel with the west boundary line of said section, three thousand and thirty five and 51/100 (4,035.51) feet, more or less, to the south line of land of R.
