Collins, as the sole surviving heir of his mother Rosa Collins, deceased, and vested in the Complainant S.W. Collins.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the Complainant S.W. Collins pay all the cost of this proceeding including a fee of Ten Dollars to J. L. Peters the Guardian Ad Litem appointed and representing the minor respondent in this cause, for all of which let execution issue.
