Harris excepting the William Yancey Harris and the descendants of Overton C. Harris, sons of the said Benjamin F. Harris, who are hereinafter referred to; that with the exceptions of the descendants of the said Overton C. Harris the following constitute all of the heirs at law of the said Benjamin F.Harris;

- (1) The first child of Benjamin F. Harris was Mary Anne Harris McLaughlin who married M. W. McLaughlin, both of whom are now dead, having died intestate. The following are her only heirs at law;
- 1. George B. McLaughlin a son, who is now dead having died intestate, and whose wife is also dead. He left surviving himtwo children as his sole heirs at law;
- (1) Bert McLaughlin, a son, who is now living and who is unmarried.
- (2) M.E. McLaughlin, a son, whose wife is named Josie McLaughlin both of whom are now living.
- 2. Leona McLaughlin (who is the same person as Z.L. McLaughlin) a daughter, who is unmarried and who is now living.
- 3. Sidney J.McLaughlin, a son, who is now dead, having died intestate but whose widow, Mary I. McLaughlin, is now living. He left surviving him the following ashis sole heirs at law:
- (1) Mrs.Alice Ingram, a daughter, whose husband is named Robert D. Ingram, both of whom are now living.
- (2) Loraine McLaughlin a daughter, who is unmarried and is now living.
- (3) E. L. McLaughlin, a son, whose wife is named Mignon McLaughlin both of whom are now living.
- (4) R.L.McLaughlin, a son, whose wife is named Frances McLaughlin, both of whomare nowliving.
- (5) Gypsie M.Goodwin, whose husband is named R.E.Goodwin, both of whom are now living.
- 4. Etta McLaughlin, (who is also known as M. E. McLaughlin) a daughter, who is unmarried and who is now living.
- 5. J. B. McLaughlin, a son, who is unmarried and who is now living.
- (2) The second child of Benjamin F. Harris was Jane Harris, a daughter, who died intestate about the year 1894, unmarried, never having had anychildren.
- (3) The third child of said Benjamin F. Harris was Overton C. Harris, a son, who is now dead and whose wife is also dead. The said Overton C. Harris while a young man, moved to the State of Texas and affiant has always heard that he had a number of children some of whom affiant has seen, but affiant does not know their names.
- (4) The fourth child of Benjamin F. Harris was Ben H. Harris, a son, who died

intestate prior to the year 1892, unmarried, never having had any children.

- (5) The fifth child of Benjamin F. Harris was William Yancey Harris, a son, whom affiant never knew personally but who so affiant has heard, was killed during the war between the States while a young man without ever having married and without leaving a will.
- (6) The sixth child of Benjamin F. Harris was Mariah Elizabeth Acton, a daughter, whose husband was Dr. W. M. M. Acton, both she and her husband having died intestate leaving surviving one child as her sole heir at law;
- 1. Maude Acton Lee, a daughter whose humband is named W.N.Lee, both of whom are now living.
- (7) The seventh child of Benjamin F. Harris was Ellen Dawson (who is the same person as Rachele E. Dawson) her husband having died about the year 1917, intestate, leaving surviving him his said widow, and the following three children as his heirs at law:
- 1. Florence D. Lee, whose husband is Clyde Lee, both of whom are now living.
- 2. Mary Elizabeth Jones, whose husband is H. M. Jones, both of whom are now living.
- 3. Frank J. Dawson, whose wife is Maude Dawson, both of whom are now living.
- (8) The eighth child of Benjamin F. Harris was Sampson W. Harris (who was also called Sam Harris and Samp Harris) whoo died intestate about six or eight years ago leaving no descendants surviving him, being a widower at the time of his death. his wife having died prior to the date of his death.

Affiant further states that the said Benjamin F. Harris did not leave any child or descendants of a deceased child surviving him other than those hereinabove named and that all of the heirs at law whose names are givenabove as now living are over the age of twenty one years and are of sound mind.
