know all men by these presents that I (we) S. J. Patton and wife J. L. Patton hereinafter referred to as seller, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Eight and No/100 Dollars (\$58.00) and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant anto the Southern Natural Gas Corporation hereinafter referred to a purchaser, a right of way to lay, construct maintain and operate a pipe line or lines, consisting of one or more pipes, and appurtenances thereto, including telephone or telegraph lines in connection therewith, and the free right of ingress and egress to and fromsaid right of way for the purpose of laying, constructing, maintaining, repairing, replacing, operating or removing at will said pipe line and said appurtenances thereto, across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama;

Eighty (80) acres of land more or less in the southeast quarter (SE 1_4) and in the east half (E 1_2) of east half (E 1_2) of southwest quarter (SW 1_4) of Section twenty, two (22), the same being an oblong shape running from east to west and containing all of said southeast quarter (SE 1_4) and east half (E 1_2) of east half (E 1_2) of southwest quarter (SW 1_4) of saidSection except that part sold by J. E. R.Davidson and J. G.Fields to Griffin lying in the northwest part of said quarter section southeast and east of Prairie Branch and that part sold bysaid J. E. R. Davidson to John T. Jonesey in northern part of said southeast quarter (SE 1_4) and east half (E 1_2) of southwest quarter (SW 1_2) and west of Prairie Branch and also excepting eighty (80) acres in southern part of said tract sold by said Davidson to J.G. Field and known by the name of the 1_4 ddle place "The said eighty (80) acres being bounded on north by said land sold to Griffin and Jonsey and on south by land known as the fiddle place" same being in Section twenty two (22) township twenty (20), south, range three (3) west, being the same land acquired and more fully described as per deed of record in Book 43 page 417 of the records of Shelby County, Alabama.

To have and to hold the same together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including all rights of ingress and egress as above set forth, and the right to cut and keep clear all trees that may injure or endanger said lines unto the said purchaser, its successors and as signs forever; provided that if the purchaser, its successors or assigns, should permanently abandon the use of said right of way for all of the purposes hereinstated, then the easements hereinsgranted and all rights incident thereto shall terminate. Provided further, that the seller especially reservessthe use and enjoyment of the premises herein described, subject only to the exercise of the rights and privileges herein granted to the purchaser.

It is understood and agreed that the purchaser shall ay said pipe line below plow depth, wherever it crosses any land that may be cleared and in cultivation, and shall also lay said pipe line below plow depth across any land that may in the future be cleared and put in cultivation.

The location of said right of way on the above described land shall be determined by the purchaser, but said pipe line shall not be laid nearer than __feet to any barn residence or tenant house on said lands without written consent of the seller.

The purchaser shall pay all damage to fences, crops and timber which may be suffered by reason of installation, maintenance operation or alteration of said pipe

line and appurtenances thereto. If not mutually agreed upon, said damages are to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the owner of the premises one by the grantee, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of tso of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.
