

## POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALLMEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Whereas, the Wilton Land & Improvements Company an Alabama Corporation, did on the 23rd day of May, 1919 execute a mortgage on certain real estate, to the Southern Mineral Land Company an Alabama corporation, securing the sum of \$19,000.00 which said mortgage was filed in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, June 21st, 1919, and recorded in Volume 126 of Mortgages on pages 364 et seq., and

Whereas, on or about the 22nd day of November 1929 the Southern Mineral Land Company received \$2374.16 in full settlement of the balance due on said indebtedness.

Now therefore in consideration of said payment said Southern Land Company does hereby release and discharge from the lien of said mortgage hereinabove described, all the property therein described, and being in Bibb and Shelby Counties as aforesaid;

And further, in consideration of the premises, said Southern Mineral Land Company does hereby constitute and appoint Cage Head, Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama its true and lawful attorney in fact to enter satisfaction of said mortgage on the records of Shelby County, Alabama, hereby authorizing said Judge of Probate to endorse satisfaction of said mortgage on the records of Shelby County and to sign the Company's name to such endorsement.
