## PIPE LINE PERMIT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, James Albright and wife Dulcie 3. Albright, Ferman Albright and wife Lydia Albright, James Franklin Albright and wife Laura Albright, Dovey Albright Wyatt and husband A.G.Wyatt, and Aldis E.Albright, R.J. Albright, Ruby Albright, Mrs. Lorene Coten, Gra Albright and Ruth Albright, all heirs of the estate of S.J. Albright, deceased Twenty Five Collars (\$25.00) and ther good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto Southern NaturalGas Corporation hereinafter referred to as purchaser, a right of way to lay, construct, maintain and operate a pipe line or lines, consisting of one or more pipes, and appurtenences thereto, including telephone or telegraph lines in connection therewith, and the free right of ingress and egress to and fromsaid right of way for the purpose of laying, constructing, maintaining, repairing, replacing, operating or removung at will said pipe line and said appurtenances thereto, across the following described lands situated in Chelby County, Alabama;

Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section thirty one (31), Township twenty one (21) range two (2) west, being the same land acquired and more fully described as per deed of record in Book 34, page 33 of the records of Shelby County, A<sub>1</sub>abana. Said right of way tobe thirty (30) feet inwidth. It is agreed that we, our succesors or assigns, shall have the right to build two or more fences across said right of way

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including all rights of ingress and egress as above set forth, and the right to cut and keep clear all trees that may injure or endanger said lines onto the said purchaser, its successors and assigns, forever; provided that if the purchaser, its successors or assigns should permanently abandon the use of said right of way for all of the purposes herein stated, then the easements herein granted and all rights incident thereto, shall terminate. Provided, further, that the seller especially reserves the use and enjoyment of the premises herein described, subject only to the exercise of the rights and privileges herein granted to the purchaser.

It is understood and agreed that purchaser shall lay said pipe line below plow depth wherever it crosses any land that may be cleared and in cultivation, and shall also lay said pipe line below plow depth across any land that may inthe future be cleared and put in cultivation.

The locat on of said right of way on the above described land shallbe determined by the purchaser, but said pipe line shall not be laid nearer than \_\_\_feet to any barn, residence or tenant house on said lands without written consent of the seller.

The purchaser shallpay all damages to fences, crops and timber which may be suffered by reason of installation, maintenance, operation or alteration of said pipe line and appurtenances thereto. If not mutually agreed upon, said damages are to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the owner of the premises, one by the grantee, and the third by the twoso appointed as aforesaid, and the award of two of such three persons

shall be final and conclusive.
