know alimen by these Presents, that I (we) T.W. Johnson a single man, hereinafter referred to as seller, for and in consideration of the sum of

R of W 6660ne Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the Southern Natural Gas Corporation hereinafter referred to as purchaser, a right of way to lay, construct, maintain and operate a pipe line or lines, consisting of one or more pipes, and appurtenances thereto, including telephone or telegraph lines in connection therewith and the free right of ingress and egress to and fromsaid right of way for the purpose of laying, constructing, maintaining repairing, replacing, operating or removing at willsaid pipe line and said appurtenances thereto, across the following described lands situated in Shelby County Alabama; It is expressly understood that the above and purchaser hereby agrees that the right of ingression and egression to and from said right of way shall be on no other lands hereinafter described than the right of way herein mentioned except roads now in use.

Northeast quarter/of northwest quarter (NW\frac{1}{4}) of Section twenty seven (27) township twenty (20) south, range three (3) west. Aso a tract of land known as the "L.N. Roy Homestead" described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of south west quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty two (22), Township twenty (20) south, range three (3) west, thence east along section line 660 feet to lane between Roy and Riddle land, thence north 2° west along said land 1984 feet, thence west 26° north 341 feet to stake, thence 3° 30' north 275 feet to stake on top of hill, thence south 2° 15' east 208 feet, thence 30° north along wire fence 208 feet, thence north 9° west 451 feet to hite Oak on side of "oad thence north west along said road 160feet to Hillsboro Brankh, thence in a south westerly direction along branch to Section line, thence east along section line to point of beginning and the following described piece of land surrounding the house that C.MM.Roy and wife now own, known as the "Mrs. Mary L. Thompson Place" commencing ab the conglomerated boulder near the large oak stump, thence due south to a cedar stake at corner of potato patch, thence easterly veering a little horthwardato a cedar stake on top of the old Harmony Church Ridge, thence northerly along top of ridge to a rock and stop, thence easterly to the rock corner at Settlement road, thence along saild wagon road to the conglomerated boulder at point of commencement, containing three (3) acres, constituting in all one hundred and eight (108) acres more or less being the same land acquired and more fully described as per deed of record in Book 88 page 41 of the records of Shelby County, Alabama.

Said pipe line to be laid as pe survey now made within right of way 30 ft. in width ingression and egression over right of way only except roads in use pipe line must not interfere with flow of water in ditches 24 inches in depth, or through this farm. The above consideration covers all damages during construction on or over said right of way.

To have and to hold the same together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including allrights of ingress and egress as above set forth, and the right to cut and keep clear all trees that may injure or endanger said lines unto the said purchaser, its

successors and assigns for ever.

provided tha if the purchaser, its successors or assigns should permanently abandon the use of said right of way for all of the purposes herein stated, then the easements herein granted and all rights incident thereto shall terminate. Provided further, that the seller especially reserves the use and enjoyment of the premises herein described, subject only to the exercise of the rights and privileges herein granted to the purchaser.

It is understood and agreed that purchaser shall lat said pipe line below plow depth wherever it crosses any land that may be cleared and in cultivation, and shall also lay said pipe line below plow depth across any land that may in the future be cleared and put in cultivation.

The location of said right of way on the above described land shallbe determined by the purchaser, but said pipe line shall not be laid nearer than feet to any barn, residence or tenant house on said lands without written consent of the seller.

The purchaser shall pay all damages to fences, crops and timber which may be suffered by reason of installation, maintenance, operation or alteration of said pipe line and appurtenances thereto. If not mutually agreed upon, said damages are to be ascertained and determined bythree disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the owner of the premises, one by the grantee and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of two of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.
