TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING:

Whereas, John W. Kidd of St. Clair County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John W. Kidd according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the "Public Lands" for the east half of the northeast quarter of Section twelve of Township 19 of Range two (east) in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing eighty acres and thirteen hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said John W. Kidd.

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John W. Kidd the said tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said John W. Kidd, and his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I James Monroe President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
