Before me Henry W. Naish, N.P. &Ex Off.J.P. inand for said County in said State, personally appeared R. H. Walker, who being dulysworn deposes and says as follows:

My name is R. H, Walker, and I am 75 years of age, and have resided within 2 miles of all of the NW_4^1 of NE_4^1 and NE_4^2 of NE_2^1 of Section 14, Tp. 20, name 3 west lying west of the creek, which is inreality known as DensonCreek in Shelby County, Alabama, for 40 years.

Affiant further states tharhe has often seen and observed said lands during all of said years and that on the 2nd day of January, 1888, Wm. J.Cross went into possession of maid lands by virtue of a deed from J.M.Cross, as administrator if the estate of W. B.Cross, and occupied said lands and held the same openly, notoriously, peaceably and adversely unto the entire world up to and until the 8th day of December, 1888, when he transferred his right, title and interest to said lands to Vincent Ellison.

Affiant further states that Vincent Ellison went into possession of said land by virtue of said transfer on the 8th day of December 1888, occupied the same as a home and claimed and held the same openly, notoriously, peaceably and adversely to the entire world, cultivated said lands and maintained fences around the entire tract from said date named up to and until the date of his death, which was February 12, 1914.

Affiant further states that the said Vincant Ellison, who was one and the same person as V.J. Ellison, as said name appeared in transactions both ways, left as his sole heirs at law A.C.Ellison, I.C. Ellison, V. J.Ellison, Jr. Eva A. Lambert, Emma Roy, Wm.Robert Ellison, Jim Ellison or J. C.Ellison, who is one and the same person, and W. C.Ellison, Violet Cross, CarlCross, Ruby Cross and Garland Cross, who being the minor children of Rosa Ellison Cross, deceased, and her hubband Charlie Cross.

Affiant further states that onthe 29th day of August, 1914, the said Jim Ellison or J.C.Ellison, W.C.Ellison and I.C.Ellison each of whom were single men at such time, and heirs of the estate of V. J.Ellison, deceased, executed to T. W. Johnson a deed convehing their interest in the above described lands, and that on the 25th day of May 1915, A. C.Ellison as administrator of the said V. J. Ellison, deceased, conveyed the interest of all of said heirs to said T.W.Johnson by administrator's deed, said lands having been sold for the purpose of paying debts.

Affiant further states that during all the time between the death of the said V. J.Ellison the said lands were in possession of the said heirs of the said V. J.Ellison deceased, they holding the same openly, notoriously, peaceably and adversely to the entire world up to and until the 29th day of August, 1914, when three interests in said land were conveyed to said T.W.Johnson, and that the said T.W.Johnson with the other heirs of V. J. Ellison named in the administrator's deed above mentioned held and claimed said property as had V. J.Ellison before them up to and untilthe 25th day of May 1915, when T.W. Johnson by virtue of the deed from A.C. Ellison, as administrator of V.J. Ellison, went into possession of said lands and has had the same occupied, continually by tenant, the said Johnson holding said land openly, notoriously, peaceably and adversely, having thex same cultivated

by tenant and enclosed by fence continually from the said 25th day of May, 1915 up to and including the date of the making of this affidavit.

Affiant further states that while he has lived in the community where this land is located for many years he has at no time heard the title or title of possession of said T.W. Johnson, the heirs of V.J. Ellison, V. J. Ellison, or Vincent Ellison, who is one and the same person or Wm. J. Cross questioned at any time from this date up to and including the 2nd day of January, 1888 when Wm. J. Cross purchased said lands from the administrator of W. B. Cross, deceased.
