The undersigned affiant, Stonecypher, being first duly sworn, doth depose and say that he has lived continuously in Shelby County for more than thirty years; that he is wellacquainted with the farm, or tract of land,

The west half ( $\mathbb{W}_{2}$ ) of the southwest quarter ( $\mathbb{S}\mathbb{W}_{3}$ ) of Section 5,  $\mathbb{T}_{0}$  waship 22, Range 2 west, less twenty five (25) acres off the north end, and the east half  $(E_2^1)$  of the southeast quarter  $(SE_2^1)$  of Section 6, Township 22, Range 2, west, less twenty five (25) acres off the north end of that; that this is a farm, with improvements thereon, known as the " $Mc^C$ linton Place"; that affiant has been acquainted with the land and the occupants thereof for fully twenty nine years; that it is the same land and farm recently conveyed by deed from Mrs. T. E. Walker and J.H. Walker, her hasband, to W. G. Hayden, that when affiant first knew the property the houses were occupied by and the land cultivated by N. V.
