Personally appeared before me G.W.Stone who being duly sworn deposes and says:
I know J. O.Thomas as owner of the following described lands: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ except 3 acres deeded to the church on said land and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and a part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ described as follows: Beginning at the SE corner and running north to the creek 142 yards, fromthence along said creek in a northerly direction to an old ford of said creek 208 yards from thence running south to the south bound ary and from thence east along said south boundary line to the beginning and containing 8 acres more or less, all in Section 24, Township 20, Range 2 west, containing 125 acres more or less and situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
