TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING: Whereas, Lewis Condray of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Lewis Condray according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the public lands", for the west half of the southeast quarter of Section thirtyfive, in Townhip nine teen, of "ange two east, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing eighty acres and twenty eight hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office of the surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Lewis Condray.

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and inconformity with the several acts of $C_{\rm O}$ ngress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Lewis Condray and to his keirs, the said tract above described: $T_{\rm O}$ have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature therunto belonging unto the said Lewis $C_{\rm O}$ ndray and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In witness whereof I Andrew Jackson President of the United States of America have caused these presence to be made patent and the seal of the general land office to be hereunto affixed.
