the following described Real Estate, to wit:

situated in Shelby County, State of Alabama, to-wit: that portion of lot numbered three hundred ninety eight (398) of the survey known and designated as Shelby Lime Company's allotment of lots, in the town of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama, and described as follows: Begin at the southwest corner of said lot numbered three hundred ninety eight (398) for a starting point, said point being the intersection of the east line of an alley with the south line of said lot three hundred ninety eight (398); run thence east along the south line of said lot three hundred ninety eight (398), seventy five (75) feet, more or less, to the southwest corner of that portion of said lot now owned by the said Julius B. Cooper, thence north parallel with the east line of said alley and along the west line of said land now owned by said Julius B. Cooper, twenty five (25) feet; thence west and parallel with the south line of said lot seventy five (75) feet to the east line of said alley; thence south along the east line of said alley to the point of beginning.
