

## AFFIDAVIT

Before me Pauline Bird, a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, personally appeared W. W. Wallace who being duly sworn deposes and says that he has known the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and W $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 12, Tp. 20, Range 2 east situated in Shelby County Alabama, since about the year 1881 that when affiant first knew the same it was in the possession of Mary Chancellor and her daughter Mattie Chancellor the said Mary Chancellor being the widow of J. M. Chancellor or Mat Chancellor and Mattie Chancellor being the only child and sole heir at law of the said J. M. Chancellor.

Affiant further states that Mary Chancellor after the death of her said first husband J. M. Chancellor married Eugene Williams and MATTIE Chancellor married B. F. Robertson and that the names of Mary Williams appearing in the abstract of the above described property is one and the same person as Mary Chancellor, the widow of J. M. Chancellor, and Mattie Robertson whose name appears in said abstract is one and the same person as Mattie Chancellor the only child and sole heir at law of said J. M. Chancellor, deceased.

Affiant further states that from the said year 1881 said Mary Chancellor Williams and Mattie Chancellor Robertson who have been identified above, occupied as a home, claimed to own, paid the taxes upon, and held peaceably and adversely to the entire world all of said land from said 1881 up to and until August 21, 1907, when Mary Williams and her husband conveyed their interest in said land to Mattie Robertson; that Mattie Robertson has held, claimed, managed and possessed said land from said August 21, 1907, as did she and her mother before her from said last named date up to and until the date of the making of this affidavit.
