

## AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF ALABAMA )

Before me the undersigned authority personally appeared W. T. Crumpton who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he knew Michael Quinn during his life time and that he left surviving him the following named children and who were the only children of said Michael Quinn, to-wit: Pollie, Mahaley, Elizabeth, Martha, Phebe, and Loftin Quinn.

That Michael Quinn lived on the following described lands, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and N $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, all in Tp. 21, Range 1 east, Shelby County, Alabama.

That Phebe Quinn married John Anderson and that Martha Quinn married W. J. Mitchell. That Martha Quinn was living on the above described lands at the time she married W. J. Mitchell and continued to live on said lands until her death in 1924. That Martha Quinn married W. J. Mitchell about the year 1880, and was living on this land at the time she married him and continued to live on it until her death. That Martha Quinn and W. J. Mitchell has only two children, Mattie E. Mitchell and Mary Elizabeth Mitchell. That Mary Elizabeth Mitchell was called and known as Bessie. That Mattie E. Mitchell married T. W. Porter and Mary Elizabeth Mitchell married B. W. Almon.

That Martha Mitchell and husband W. J. Mitchell lived on the above lands from about 1880 all the time claiming to own it, paying taxes regularly on it, and were in the open actual, exclusive, continuous and hostile adverse possession of this land until her death and that their title and possession were never disputed or questioned by any one.

That after the death of Martha Mitchell and husband W. J. Mitchell the children, Mattie E. Mitchell, and M. E. Mitchell were in the possession of the above lands as owners, paying taxes and claiming to own same.
