

AFFIDAVIT

Before me Edgar W. Carter a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, personally appeared W. J. Weldon who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says that he is acquainted with the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, and has known the same for more than thirty years prior thereto, viz:

Commencing at the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 1, Township 21, Range 1 east, and running thence south 87 degrees 30 minutes west 105 feet to a starting point, or point of beginning for the lot herein conveyed, running thence south 87 degrees 30 minutes west 315 feet to the northeast corner of the present public school lot, thence north 2 degrees 30 minutes west 210 feet, thence north 87 degrees 30 minutes east 315 feet, thence south 2 degrees 30 minutes east to the point of beginning, containing 1.5 acres, more or less, and situated in the town of Wilsonville, Alabama.

Further deposing affiant says that the above described lot is one and the same lot which was conveyed by E. W. Holland and wife N. E. Holland, to the Trustees of the M. E. Church south, Wilsonville Circuit, North Alabama Conference, on the 24th day of September 1898 and which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 84, at page 262.

Further deposing affiant says that the grantee in the last named deed, through its trustees, have been in possession of said lot continuously from the date of said last mentioned deed until it was deeded by the trustees of said church, to the State of Alabama, by deed dated June 7th, 1930, and which deed was executed by C. C. Farr, James Evans, J. P. Harkins and W. L. Smith, as Trustees, and who at that time were the sole and only trustees of said church.

Further deposing affiant says that said possession of said land during said period was actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, and adverse, and at no time during said period were any claims advanced to said land or any interest therein, antagonistic to the possession and ownership of said church.
