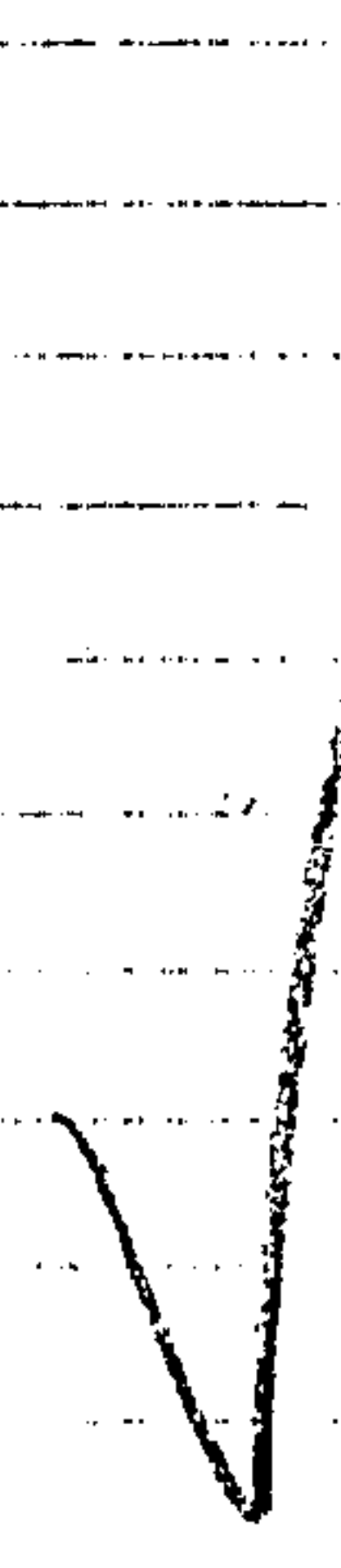


# THE STATE OF ALABAMA, SHELBY COUNTY

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and all that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  that lies  
 east of the public dirt road leading from Columbiana to Shelby, Alabama, except ten acres  
 more or less, off of the south side of the above described lands. The cross fence between  
 the lands herein conveyed and the lands known as the R. O'Hara home place being the
