

AFFIDAVIT

Before the undersigned authority personally appeared Mrs. Bessie Brown, who being duly sworn deposes and says that she is a daughter of the late ^{H.}Clay Reynolds, and his first wife Mary J. Reynolds, deceased, the mother of his children; that said H. Clay Reynolds died intestate, in Tampa Florida, where he was then living on to-wit: the 20th day of November 1920; that all his debts have been paid, that he was survived by his widow, whose name is Augusta Reynolds and by the following named children, and descendants of children who had died prior to the 12th day of February, 1921, viz:

William B. Reynolds, Bessie Brown, Eugene D. Reynolds, Fred K. Reynolds, Belle Hogan, Harry C. Reynolds, Lucia White, children; and the following grand children, viz: John L. Reynolds and Eugene D. Reynolds Jr. sons of H. E. Reynolds, deceased and Virginia Jones and Lucia Jones, daughters of Maude Reynolds Jones, deceased; that the above named children and grand children of said H. Clay Reynolds and the said Augusta Reynolds, his widow, constituted his sole heirs on the 12th day of February 1921 and on February 1, 1921, when said Augusta Reynolds, widow, conveyed to them her interest in certain parts of lot number 21, in the town of Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama, that they are the same children and grand children who are grantors in that certain deed dated to-wit: the 14th day of March 1921 and recorded in the deed record of Shelby County, Alabama, Vol. 71, page 13, conveying a certain part of said lot number 21 to P. C. Wilson; that the wives ^{and} or husbands of such of said heirs as were, on the date of said last mentioned conveyance married, are correctly named in said conveyance and joined as grantors therein; that no part of the property conveyed by said deed and no part of said lot number 21, has ever been the homestead or any part of the homestead of any of the grantors of said conveyance.
