Farr of the second part all of the County aforesaid, witnesseth: that the said John G. Farr and Permela Farr his wife have sold and conveyed unto the said James W. Farr of the second part the following land lying and being in said County known as follows to-wit: the west half of the northwest quarter of section twenty eight in township twenty of Range one east in the District of Tuskaloosa, Alabama containing eighty acres more or less for the consideration of the sum of One Hundred & Fifty Dollars to us in hand paid by the said James W. Farr the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said first part in consideration of which said first part have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell to the aforesaid James W. Farr and to his heirs for ever the land aforesaid to have and to hold and we John G. Farr and Perlema Farr his wife of the first part will forever warrant and defend the title fee the sum for said land to him the said James W. Farr and to his heirs forever in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this December 18 day A. D. 1855.
