L.Crumpton who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he was acquainted with Joseph H.Acker, who formerly owned the east half of the northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 21, Range 1 east, Shelby County, Alabama, except that portion thereof lying south of the Fort Williams Ferry Road.

Further deposing affiant says that immediately after the execution of the deed of Lester & Company to Joseph H.Acker on the 22nd day of November, 1900, and which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 23 at page 272, said Joseph H.Acker went into the actual possession of said land and remained in the actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of the same until he sold and deeded it to J.W. Chappell on the 29th day of August 1911 which deed is recorded in the probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 45 at page 328.

Further deposing affiant says that during and throughout the time aforesaid, said Joseph H.Acker actually resided upon said land and cultivated portions of it each and every year.

Further deposing affiant says that said J.W.Chappell immediately after the execution of the last mentioned deed went into the actual possession of said land and resided upon it and cultivated portions of it and remained in the actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of the same each year and continuously from the date of said deed until he sold and deeded the same to I. J. Chappell, by deed dated April 28th 1924, and which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 73 at page 227.
