

DECREE

John Hudson Grimes, deceased, estate of) Probate Court
 Decree confirming exemptions to widow) April 21st, 1930

This cause coming on to be heard from the report of J.W. Lybrand and J.M. Truitt who were heretofore on the 13th day of December, 1929, appointed Commissioners and on March 15th 1930, re-appointed Commissioners to make a full and complete inventory and appraisement of the real estate and personal property belonging to said decedent, and to set apart the same as exempt to Mary S. Grimes, the widow of said decedent, which said report was filed in this court on the 20th day of March and set for hearing on this day.

And it appearing to the court that no exceptions or objections have been filed to said report, and that said thirty days for such exceptions or objections have expired since the filing of said report; and the heirs having had notice as directed by law; and it appearing to the court from said report, that said real estate hereinafter described was all of the property owned and left by said decedent at the time of his death, and that said property is less in value and area than the amount of exemptions allowed by law to the widow and minor children or either of them, and it further appearing to the court that said decedent left no minor child or children, and that said commissioners did set apart the real estate to Mary S. Grimes, the widow of said J.H. Grimes, deceased, as exempt to her as provided in Article 4 Chapter 292 of the Code of Alabama 1930.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said report of said commissioners be and the same is hereby in all things ratified and confirmed and that said real estate as follows: East $\frac{1}{2}$ of northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 19, Range 1 east, this being all the property owned by said decedent at the time of his death, and being in Shelby County, Alabama, be and the same is hereby set apart as exempt to said Mary S. Grimes, the widow of said deceased. It is further ordered that said Mary S. Grimes pay the cost of this proceeding for which execution may issue.
