Thirty acres off the south end of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter; ten acres off the north side of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter; and nineteen acres in the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of said southwest quarter of southeast quarter, and running thence north 990 feet, thence west 858 fdet, thence south 990 feet to the section line, thence east along the section line to the point of beginning; all of said land being in Section 8, Township 21 range 2 west, in Shelby County, Alabama.

The Caginaw Lime and Lumber Company, however reserves to itself and excepts from this conveyance all the iron ore, stone, shale, coal and other minerals contained in or upon said land together with all timber and water upon the same, which may be required for the development, working and mining of said minerals, and the preparation of the same for the removal of the same to market; and the grantor herein does also reserve the right to build roads, tram roads and railroads of any description over said pramises which may be desired for the transportation of said minerals from said land, and for the transportation to and over said lands all material and implements useful in the mining and removal of said minerals or in the preparation of the same for market.
