That he was President of the Bessemer State Bank, of Bessemer, Alabama, on the 9th day of June, 1913 and that he continued as President of said Bank from June 9th, 1913, until some time during the year of 1916.

The affiant further avers and says that he was familiar with that certain mortgage executed by Cynthia A. Sturdivant and husband, W. H. Sturdivant to the said Bessemer State Bank, on the 9th day of June 1913 secured by the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ except 10 acres in the SE corner of said forty, in Section 26, Township 20, Range 4 west, Shelby County, Alabama, and other lands, said mortgage being for the sum of \$650.00 and is of record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in mortgage Book 102 at page 532.

The affiant further avers and says that during the time that he was President of the said Bessemer State Bank that the above described mortgage was paid and satisfied in full and that the said Bessemer State Bank at the time it was dissolved held no claim whatsoever against the above described property, and that he is giving this affidavit for the purpose of satisfying, releasing and discharging all interest and claims which the said Bessemer State Bank may have against the property described herein by virtue of the mortgage described herein.
