do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Joseph T. Crowe and wife Ethel G. Crowe
the following described property—to wit:

That part of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and that part of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 4, township
24, north Range 13 east, Shelby County, Ala. lying and being north of the Southern Railroad
and south of the old Calera and Montevallo public dirt road and west of the Calera
Land Company's property and east of the Dock Wood's land, (The Calera Land Company's
lands referred to above lie in the east half of the NW 1/4 and the lands of Dock Wood's are
