

SHERIFF'S DEED

WHEREAS, an execution issued from the Circuit Court of Shelby County, against John Hope et al in favor of Columbiana Savings Bank for Pate Mercantile Co. in a judgment rendered in said Court at the January Term thereof, in 1930, for the sum of One Hundred Fifty Six and No/100 Dollars, besides costs of suit, which said execution came into my hands as Sheriff of said County, on the 7th day of April 1931, to execute and return according to law; by virtue of which execution above recited, I did, as Sheriff aforesaid, levy upon the following property of the said John Hope, to-wit:

Pate became the purchaser of said property so levied on as aforesaid, for the sum of Seventy Nine and 93/100 Dollars, he being the highest, best and last bidder for the same.

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that for and in consideration of the premises, and of the payment by said G. W. Pate of the said sum of Seventy Nine and 93/100 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I do hereby sell, convey, transfer and set over to the said G.W.Pate all the legal right, title, interest and claim which the said John Hope had and held in and to the foregoing described premises/
