

AFFIDAVIT

Before me the undersigned authority in and for said County and State personally appeared Foster Hamilton who being by me first duly sworn deposed and saith as follows:

That he was Cashier of the Bank of Alabama on to-wit, from March 19, 1920, to the 10th day of January, 1923. That on said March 19, 1920, said J.F. Kent transferred and assigned to said The Bank of Alabama a certain mortgage executed by M. D. Clements and wife Clara Morrid, to said J.F. Kent on said property located in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit: The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Tp. 24, Range 12 east, Shelby County, Alabama, and that said mortgage having been recorded in Mortgage Book 131, page 122, in the office of the judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama. That said M. D. Clements and wife did not pay said mortgage when the same was due and that the same was redeemed by said J. F. Kent and returned to him after the due date thereof. Luck to satisfy the mortgage on the records in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.
