

EX PARTE Hattie E. Sellers ) In Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, in Equity

At the July Term 1931 of the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, in Equity, held at Columbiana, Alabama, on the 12th day of August 1931, the Honorable E. P. Gay, Judge of said Court presiding, it was ordered and decreed as follows:

In the manner of the petition of Mrs. Hattie E. Sellers, the Mother, Charlie E. Sellers, a minor, above the age of 18 years, to-wit: of the age of 18 years and 12 days, he being without a guardian, It is made to appear to the court, by the petition and the evidence, that a publication of notice is not necessary under this petition due to the fact that said petition is filed by the mother of said minor who is not the guardian of said minor, but a copy of the said petition has been served on the minor by the Sheriff of Shelby County, Alabama, and, therefore, no such publication is required or is ordered. The Court examines the said minor and others in his behalf, and being satisfied that said minor is of sufficient intelligence to be entrusted with the management of his estate, and that it would be to his interest to grant the prayer of the petition.

It is, therefore ordered, and decreed that the said Charlie E. Sellers, a minor over the age of 18 years, be and he is hereby relieved from the disabilities of non-age, and is now invested with the right to contract, sue and be sued, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and do and perform all acts which said minor could lawfully do on his becoming of the age of 21 years, the court being satisfied that it will be to the best interest of such minor to be relieved from the disabilities of non-age.

This order and decree, however, is not to take effect until a copy shall be filed and recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate as required by law, in each county where the such minor shall thereafter reside, and in the office of the Judge of Probate of each County in this state where such minor shall do any business or make any contract.

It is further ordered and decreed, that the petitioner pay the cost of these proceedings.
