SET of SET of Section 7; SET of SWETS Section 8; that part of SWETS of SET of Section 8 lying west of McHenry's Creek (old Creek Run); all of NWETS of Section 17, except forty acres sold to Frank Pavis, and 50 acres sold to George Kroell; all that part of NWETS of NETT Section 17, lying west of McHenry's Creek; 7 acres being in a V shape and lying west of McHenry's Creek, and off of southwest corner of SWETS of NETT Section 17; also  $E_{\mathbb{R}}^{\frac{1}{2}}$  of NETT Section 18, the above land containing in all 327 acres, more or less, except 32 acres lying insecorner of this tract of land which belongs to George M.Harrison; and all of said land lying and being in Township 22 south of Range 3 west in Shelby County, Alabama, and being known as the George T.
