Beginning on the east margin of the Birmingham and Montgomery Highway at the Northwest corner of the A. M. and A. L. Word tract of land, and running thence in a northerly direction along the eastern margin of said Highway a distance of 200 feet to a point, thence in an easterly direction and parallel with the north boundary line of said A. M. & A. L.
