AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared J.L.Bush, who being by me first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says as follows: I am acquainted with the the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama, namely:

The Whole of Ed of SEd, Section 16; and Ed of Ed of NEd of Section 21, all in Township 18, Range 1 Fast; except one acre sold out of Section 21, making in all 79 acres. I have known these lands since they were deeded to Isaac Smith by R.E.Cosper and his wife in the year 1910. I know that Isaac Smith lived on these lands for a number of years, making crops on them year by year and that on or about the year 1922, he moved to the Birmingham district and since that time, his benants have been living on the place and making crops thereon.

I am also familiar with the lands that one H.A. Finley mortgaged to R.M. Isbell in the year 1919. The lands which Finley owned in Section 16 instead of being the Ed of SEZ of SEZ of Section 16 as described in the mortgage, were the Ed of Ed of SEZ of Section 16. The lands claimed by Isbell do not conflict or overlap with the lands claimed by Isaac Smith, colored. I also know the lands conveyed by A.J. Holcombe to Mrs M.A.Holcombe, his wife, in August, 1921, being described as fifty acres in the southeast corner of the Ed of Section 16, Township 18, Range 1. East, all lying and being south of the Shoops old sawmill lumber road and know of my own knowledge that the lands claimed by Mrs.Holcombe do not conflict with or overlap the lands claimed by Isaac Smith.
