

## DECREE

AND JAMES COTTRELL, GEORGE HUDDLESTON, Complainant, VS Rufe Falkner, Et.Al, Respondents.

Said cause coming to be heard, was submitted for final decree upon the Bill of Complaint as amended; the pleading signed by respondent John H. Adams, called therein "Plea of Disclaimer" filed on July 6th, 1931, and upon the decrees pro confesso against respondents Rufe P. Falkner, James Mahan, Lokie Mahan, William Parker, Dovie Parker, Ila Smith and Robert Smith, all as set forth in the Register's note of testimony filed August 24th, 1931, and same having been duly considered and the Court being of the opinion that complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for, it is now ordered and decreed as follows:

- (1) That complainant is entitled to and shall have the relief prayed for.
- (2) That complainant is the owner and entitled to possession of the following lands, situated in Township 19, South, Range 1 West, in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit: All of Section 4, except  $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and E $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; all of Sections 9 and 16; all of Section 17, except NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and E $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; all of Section 30, except SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; all of Section 31, except NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; and that neither of respondents have any interest in or claim thereon.
- (3) That all conveyances and writings relating to said lands which any of respondents may have executed to any other respondent or respondents are hereby concealed and held for naught.
- (4) That respondents, and each of them, are hereby forever enjoined from claiming any right or interest in sand land, from trespassing or entering or committing any waste thereon, and particularly from setting out any fire on said lands, cutting trees thereon, plowing same, gathering or disturbing any crop thereon, and from slandering complainant's title thereto, and from claiming any interest, right or ownership therein; and respondents are enjoined from conspiring, confederating or agreeing among themselves or with any other person to trespass on said land or to commit any waste thereon or injury thereto or to trees and crops growing thereon, or to attempt to intimidate or put in fear complainant's tenants, agents or employees in possession thereof, or to assert any claim of right or interest therein.
- (5) That respondents shall pay all of the costs of this suit, and that execution may issue for the collection of such costs for which let no execution issue for sixty days. Done and ordered this the 25th day of August 1931.
