I am 79 years of age, and am the same John T. Wisson who sold and conveyed to Joseph Smith the lands shown in my deed recorded in Deed Book 10 on Page 527, in Office of Judge of Probate, Bibb County, Alabama; all the money due by said Joseph Smith for said property has been paid.

I went on the place as a renter in 1869. I rented from French Nabors, Administrator of Prentiss Estate. There were two suits between Nabors & Gillespies. The Gillespies won one suit. I went to see Nabors and he said had had lost the ease, and was willing to give up the possession of the place. I then bought the place from the Gillespies

I stayed on the place from 1869, when I rented it until I sold it to Joseph Smith. Joseph Smith took possession and made improvements. I sold to Joseph Smith in 1906.

I knew Joseph Farrington, who was a neighbor of mine, and lived on what was known as the Farrington Place, in Sections 11, 12 & 14, Tp 24 N. R. 11 E., on border line between Bibb & Shelby Counties, Alabama, at or near the Junction of the Mayberry & Shoal Creeks, he died to best of my recollection about 1880. His wife died before he did. He left the following sons, Jasper, Josiah, D., William, Henry, and J.E. Farrington. I think J.E. Farrington is now living at Ensley, Alabama. He did not leave any daughters or children of a deceased child.

J.D.Farrington had possession of the place after Joseph Farrington's death, until about 1900, when he moved to Montevallo, where he died.

Joseph Farrington, the father of J.D.Farrington, and said J.D.Farrington, had the actual possession of the place from time I moved on my place, hereinbefore described, and which I sold to Joseph Smith, until J.D.Farrington moved to Montevallo, then he rented it until he sold to the same Joseph Smith I sold my place to. Joseph Smith bought the Farrington Place about a year before he bought my place, & was in possession of it when he bought mine.
