TO WHOM ALL THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas, Benjamin Nugent assignee of Edward Linn of Jefferson County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edward Linn according to the provosions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entieled "An act making further prevision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North west quarter of section fourteen of Township Twenty two of Range Three West in the district of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing Eightymacres—according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Edward Linn KOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Benjamin Nugent the said tract above described: to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Benjaman Nugent, and his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, James Manroe President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
