The north-west quarter of the south-west Quarter (NW\frac{1}{2} of SW\frac{1}{4}) and thirty-one (31) acres offeof the south side of the south-west quarter of the north-west quarter (SW\frac{1}{2} of NW\frac{1}{2}) of Section twenty (20); also eight (8) acres off of the east side of the north-east quarter of the south-west quarter (NE\frac{1}{2} of SE\frac{1}{2}) of Section Nineteen (19) all in Town-ship Twenty-two (22) Range Three (3) West, said land being bounded on the north by the Montevall and Aldrich Rublic Road, on the East by the A.L. Brown and Alabama College Lands, on the south by lands of James McClellan and J.S. Prentice and on the west by the land of Montevallo Coal Mining Company abd being a part of the land heretofore known as and called "The C.C. Vandegrift Farm," said part containing seventy-nine (79) acres, more or less.
