## THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS William Kidd of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Kidd according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the north west quarter of the north east quarter of Section Twenty six in Township Nineteen, of Range Two East in the district of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama containing forty acres and ten hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said William Kidd.

NOW KNOW YE, that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said William Kidd---- and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said William Kidd and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Andrew Jackson PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA have caused these presents to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five and of the Independence of the United States the Sixtieth.


