

## AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned authority, in and for said State and County personally appeared R.E. Bowden, who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says that he has resided in the town of Calera since 1884 and that he is familiar with and well acquainted with the following described tract and parcel, of land, to-wit:

That part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, Tp. 24 Range 13 East as described in that certain deed from Christopher D. Oliver and wife, Laura A., to Calera Land Company, dated January 8, 1886, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 7, page 295, of which the following lots are a part, to-wit: Lots, 1, 2, 3, and the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 4 in Block 248; and lots 12, 13, and 14 in Block 256 in Dunstan's map and survey of the town of Calera, Alabama.

That his home, since the year 1884 has been within three blocks of the above described lots and parcels of land and since the year 1886 the date of the conveyance to the Calera Land Company as aforesaid the Calera Land Company and its successors in title have been in the hostile, actual, visible, notorious and continuous possession of said lands up until this date; that for a long period of time J.H. Dunstan was the agent of the Calera Land Company and its successors in title and had the supervision and control over the lands described above and other lands in and about Calera, Alabama; that after the death of J.H. Dunstan, J.H. Duran was the agent for and the party in possession for the Calera Land Company and its successors in title, and that at the death of said Duran A.P.R. Dahl was the agent of said interest up until the date of the conveyance by the Dimmick heirs to W.C. Gewin; that during the period of time as aforesaid he has never heard of any claim or any interest advanced adverse to the ownership of that of the Calera Land Company and its successors in title as shown by the record;; for more than forty-five years it has been known and so regarded as the Calera Land Company's property and its successors in title as shown by the record.
