

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, L.H.Ellis, a Notary Public in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Beatrice Marshall Youngblood, who is known to me and who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that she is the sole and only daughter and heir at law of Peter Marshall and Henrietta Marshall; that said Peter Marshall died intestate, in the month of November, 1903, and left surviving him his widow, Henrietta Marshall, who died intestate March 27, 1927; that at the time of his death said Peter Marshall was the owner of and in possession of the south west quarter of the north east quarter of the south east quarter of Section 12, Fractional Township 22 South Range One West, Shelby County, Alabama, that said Peter Marshall obtained said land through a deed executed by Charles Sparks and others, dated November 22nd 1901, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in deed book 27, at page 283; that said Peter Marshall and his wife, Henrietta Marshall were living upon the above described land at the time of his death, and that it constituted his homestead; that he owned no other land, at the time of his death other than that above described.

Further deposing affiant says that on the 9th day of February, 1914, the above described real estate was set aside to said Henrietta Marshall as a homestead by an order of the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama, and was the owner of said property at the time of her death.

Further deposing affiant says that from the date of the death of said Peter Marshall, said Henrietta Marshall continued to occupy said land and the dwelling house thereon as a homestead from the date of her said husband until her death, as aforesaid, and that when she died her sole and only surviving heir at law was and is affiant, said Beatrice Marshall Youngblood, who was and is the sole and only child and heir at law of said Peter Marshall and was and is the sole and only child and heir at law of said Henrietta Marshall.
