do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Otis Harris

And we do, for ourselves and our heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant with the said Otis Harris heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee-simple of said premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that we have a good right to sell and convey the said property; that we will, and our heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to said Otis Harris his heirs, executors, and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
