That----- in consideration of the sum of One & no/10--Dollars, to ~~be~~ T.W.Johnsoon  
Isaac F Johnson in hand paid by Edith Johnson, wife of T W Johnson, the receipt  
whereof we do remise, release quit claim and convey to the said Edith Johnson,  
wife of T W Johnson all our right, title interest and claim in or to the  
following real estate and personal properties; to-wit:

All of the personal and real properties that he, T W Johnson deceased, willed  
to us in his last will and testament, afore said will and testament was made  
at Pelham, Ala., in the State of Alabama, in the County of Shelby and was dated  
April 21-1923 and was witnessed by T.W.Johnson and J.L.Purvis, and signed by  
T.W.Johnson, deceased, and further the above will and Testament was Probated  
before Cage Head, Judge of <sup>the</sup> Probate Court of Shelby County, State of Alabama,  
and witnessed and was proven to be the genuine last will and testament of  
T.W.Johnson deceased, and the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, State of Alab ama
