This contract and agreement entered into this Sixth (6th) day of January. 1934, by and between Mrs Ida J. Steel hereinafter known as the Party of the first part, and Mr Jefferson or Jeff and Miss Lela Ellison hereinafter known as the parties of the second part.

The party of the first part having been left entirely helpless by sickness for the past several years now realizines that she must have some one to take care and look after her, as she is anable to take care and look after herself, Due to her physical condition that the long and continued illness has left her in.

For the past twelve months the parties of the second part have lived with and taken care of the party of the first part and their care and services to her has been entirely satisfactory to her in every way, and in such manner that the party of the first part would like to have this care and service given her by the parties of the second part continued on as long as she lives

Now for the faithful performance of this duty and care rendered to the party of the first part by the parties of the second part, she feels like they should be duly compensated for this care and services and she is willing to compensate them in the following manner

First the parties of the second part are to have all crops raised on the farm that she now occupies, and has possession to, as far as her authority will grant her to extend to them, they are to pay the taxes on said farm as part of their duty in this contract. The party of the first part has at this time Four hundred and Four dollars (\$404.00) in cash and she is holding nine dollars (\$9.00) of this to pay the expenses of this contract and she reserves one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of this money for funeral expense. She also reserves any other amount of the balance of two hundred ninety five dollars, (\$295.00) that might be needed for herself for medical attention the same to be paid out as needed

Now the party of the first part and the parties of the second part, agrees to each other to name a Depository to Deposit their money with the same to draw a legal rate of interest, this money is to be Deposited in the name of Mrs Ida J. Steel, the party of the first part on savings account. Both of the above named parties having agreed and now name the Columbiana Savings Bank as the Depository to Deposit this money with The Columbiana Savings Bank is not to pay out any money on the above name account only for medical attention as heretofore party of the first part the Columbiana Savings Bank is to hold these paid statements or bills have same to take the place of checks to complete their records and show credits against the above named account. Now the party of the first part says that at the time of her death and after all fullfilled, then the balance of this money become the sole property of Mrs Lela Fllison and the Columbiana Savings Bank is now and hereby instructed to turn the balance of this money over to Mrss Lela Fllison one of the parties of the second part the same to be in payment for the faithful performance of her duties in taking care of the party of the first part.

The party of the first part is to be the sole judge for the care and services rendered her, by the parties of the second part and if the parties of the second part fails to carry out this agreement and render the care and services and treatment towards her as they have in the last twelve months, or for any other reason that might come up in the future, the party of the first part reserves the right to end and cancel this contract and agreement with out notice and the parties of the second part agrees to vacate any and all premises of hers or which she may have access to with out notice the crops off the farm to compensate them for all duties and service rendered.

Fach of the following persons to have a copy of this contract and agreement the party of the first part, the parties of the second part, the Columbiana Savings Bank, and one copy to go to the Probate Judge of Shelby Co Ala to be recorded.
