

## AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF ALABAMA,

Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared S W Pardue and Wesley Oaley, who being duly sworn, deposes and says that they reside at Saginaw, Shelby County, Alabama; that for a period of more than thirty years last past, they have been acquainted with the following tract of land, to-wit:

A tract of land beginning at the Old Columbiana and Elyton road, and running North  $83 \frac{1}{3}$  yards, thence west  $61 \frac{3}{5}$  yards, thence south 100 yards to the point of beginning, containing  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an acres, more or less and situated in the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 21, Range 2 West, and being on the East side of the Birmingham-Montgomery Highway, and being the tract of land upon which the residence of A.L. Young is situated; that of their own personal knowledge they know that for more than thirty years last past the following named parties have owned and been in the possession of said tract of land, viz.: J.W. Ozley, Jesse Clifton Garrett, J.A. Garrett, then Jesse Clifton Garrett, Lon Fort, J.W. Nash, A.L. Young, Jesse J. Mitchell and then A.L. Young, again, being all of the owners of said land for more than thirty years last past; that A.L. Young and those through whom he claims title, and as named above, to the above described tract of land have been respectively in the open, notorious, continuous, peaceable, and adverse possession of said tract of land, claiming it as their own respectively against all the world and exercising acts of ownership over the same; that the respective owners up to the sale by J.W. Nash, to A.L. Young had regularly used the same as woodland by cutting therefrom timber for general fire and building purposes; that after the sale by J.W. Nash to A.L. Young, in 1925, the said A.L. Young built a residence and a road house on the same and it has been used for the past eight or nine years for such purposes by the owners, as listed above; that affiants have never heard the title of the said A.L. Young or those through whom he claims, as named above, title to said land to be questioned; that affiants have each resided within a mile of the above tract of land for 50 years, and they are familiar with the title and use of said tract of land.
