

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, H R Justice, a Notary Public in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared I C Justice, who is known to me and who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is acquainted with the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

The south half of the south west quarter of section 28, Township 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ Range 2 East, except right of way conveyed to the C of Ga. Ry. Company and also except one acre reserved for a school lot described as beginning at a point 1680 feet east of the SW corner of said section 28 and run north 261 feet to the south line of the dirt road, thence SE along said dirt road 240 feet, thence south 116 feet to the south line of said Section, thence West 210 feet to the point of beginning.
