

AFFIDAVIT

Before me, L.H.Ellis, a Notary Public in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared F.S.Lyman, Sr., who is known to me and who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

I am acquainted with Samuel A. Curry, one of the grantees in that certain deed executed by F. May Lyman and husband, F.S.Lyman, of date April 13, 1900, and which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 24 at page 139, in which was conveyed the following property, to-wit:

The following described lot or parcel of land lying in the town of Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit: Lot 5 in Block D of Lyman's Addition to Montevallo, according to the survey and map of said Lyman's addition to Montevallo, recorded in the Probate office of Shelby County, Alabama, the same fronting on Highland Street and running back 150 feet.

Further deposing affiant says that said Samuel A. Curry was one and the same person as S.A. Curry, who is one of the grantors in that certain deed of date December 4th, 1900, which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 26 at page 444, and in which deed F.M.Ware was the grantee, and in which the following described property was conveyed, viz:

Lot 5 in Block D of Lyman's addition to the Town of Montevallo, according to the survey and plat of said Lyman's addition as made and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, the same fronting on Highland Street and running back 150 feet.

In the first deed above referred to George R. Moore was one of the grantees and said George R. Moore was one of the grantors in the last mentioned deed.
