

That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, to W.R. Hood and wife Pearl Hood in hand paid by Mammie J. Tate, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we, do remise release, quit claim and convey to the said Mammie J. Tate, all our right, title, interest, and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

Nine Acres more or less in the SF Quarter of the N. Quarter of Section 21, Township 18, Range 1 East, more fully described as follows: begin at the NF corner of the SF Quarter of the NV Quarter of Section 21 Township 18, Range 1 Fast thence south along the north and south boundary line of said forty acres to the Montevallo Road; thence along said road in a southwesternly direction 144 yards; thence due North to the North line of said forty acres, thence Fast dong the North boundary line of the forty acres to the point of beginning containing nine acres more or less this beingapart of the land conveyed by the Alabama State Land Company to D.L.Baker, said deed being recorded in Volume 6, page 126 of the record book and Page 116 of the plat book of the Alabama State Land Company, in turn D.L.Baker and wife M.J.Baker deeded said property to W.R.Hood; W.R.Hood and wife Pearl Hood deeded a certain portion of the SF Quarter of the NW Quarter of Section 21 Township 18, Range 1 Fast to Mammie J.Tate on the 16th day of August, 1927, which boundary line was improperly, described.
