State of Alabama, Jefferson County.

Before me personally came G. B. Glascoe, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says upon oath as follows: Referring to possession of certain lands in Shelby County, Alabama, described as the No of the SW of Sec. 10, Tp. 19, South, Range 2 West, I beg to say that I have been closely acquainted with these lands since 1903. These lands were not open farm lands, but were woods, and there was no adverse possession on the part of anybody as against the owners of the legal titles thereof during the period since 1903. The first actual physical possession of these lands were by me in the early part of 1920, at a time when the legal title was held by L. S. Southard. I went on the lands under Mr. Southard in January or February 1920 and cleared 8 or 9 acres and built a small house thereon. I then bought the lands from Mr. Southard in October 1920.

There has never been any sort of adverse claim or possession of these lands against the owners of the legal titles during the time that I have known the lands, now about 25 years.
