Wiley Logan all of my rights, title, interest and claim in and to said real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

The $W\frac{1}{2}$; the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$; and the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 18, Range 1 West, less 53 acres which lies West of Oak Mountain in Jefferson County, Alabama, containing 387 acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said J. Wiley Logan, his heirs and assigns forever .
