

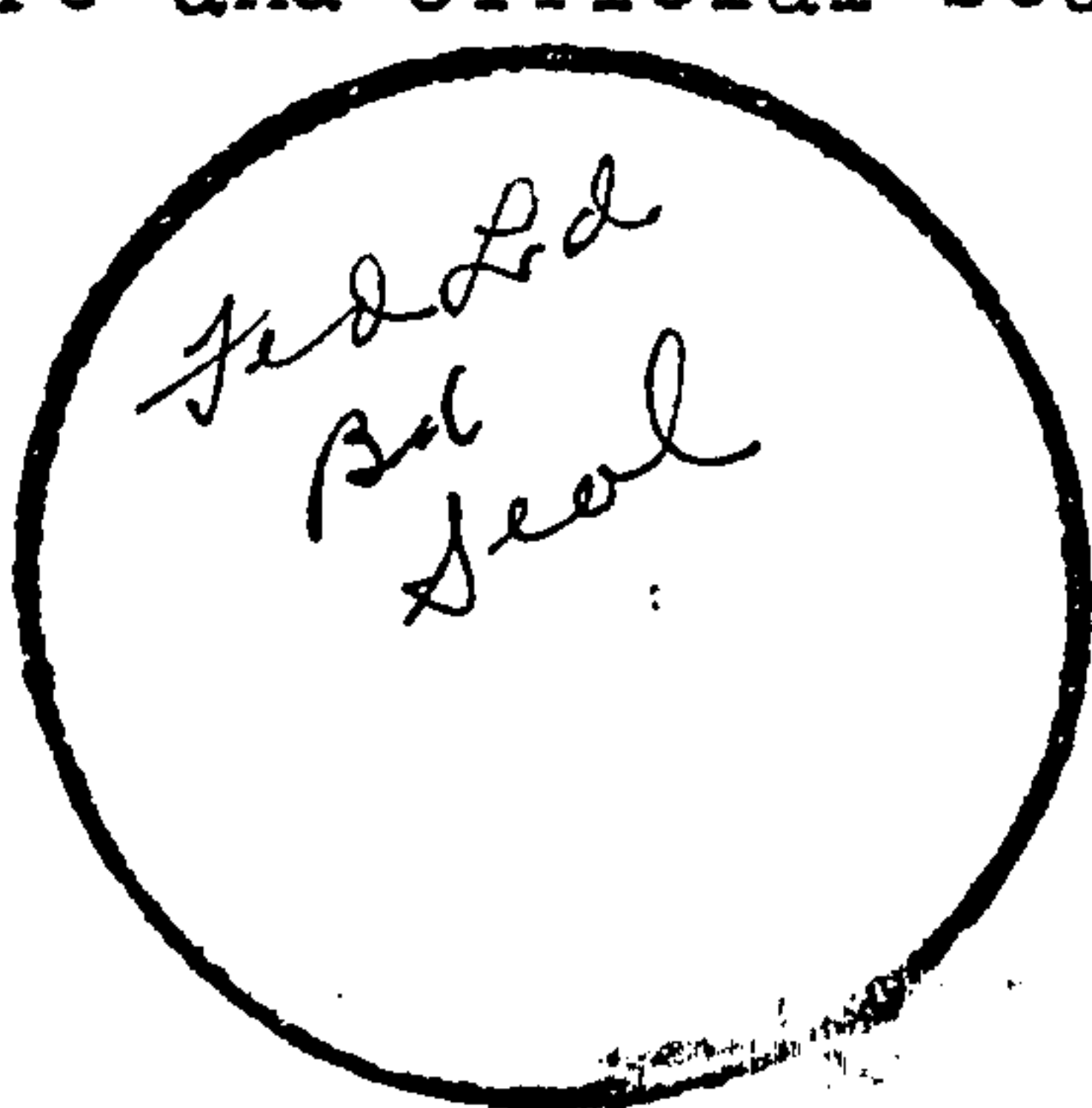
POWER OF ATTORNEY

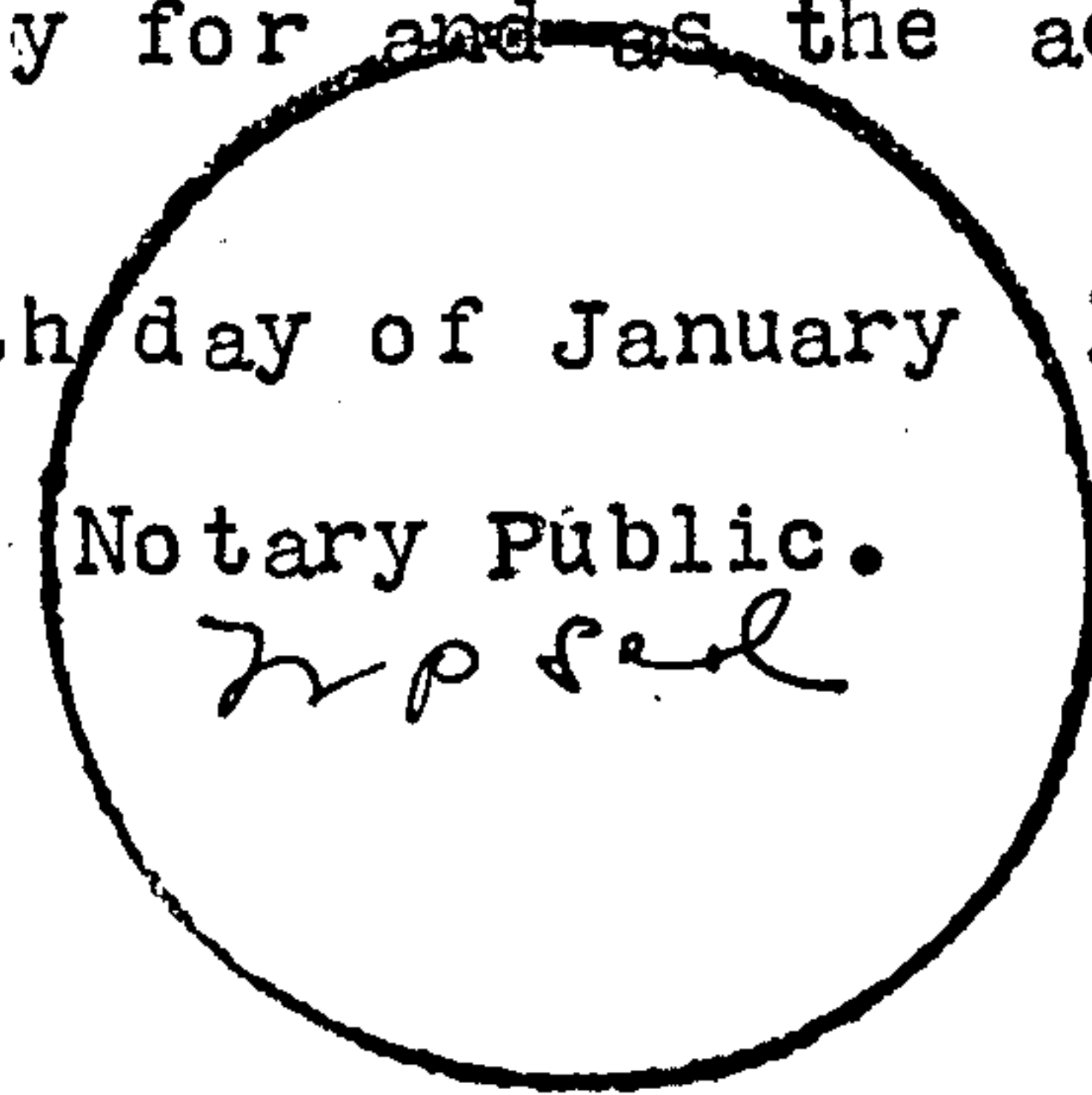
